This is a summary of the annual report of the Wabash Memorial Hospital Association, 37-0806462 for the Health and Welfare Plan for the year ended December 31, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Wabash Memorial Hospital Association has committed itself to pay certain hospital, surgical and dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

**Basic Financial Statement**

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$6,223,107 as of December 31, 2020, compared to \$7,098,625 as of December 31, 2019. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$875,518. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$15,280,894. This included employee contributions of \$8,338,805 employer contributions of \$5,462,625, reimbursement payments of \$441,707, income from investments of \$253,257, and unrealized gain on investments of \$784,500.

Plan expenses were \$16,156,412. These expenses included \$1,234,285 in administrative expenses, \$425,481 in clinic operations, \$13,896,272 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$600,374 for fees paid to preferred provider organizations.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
